

VBS 2021 Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What is the date and time?

Treasured VBS will take place at Rev City Church daily June 22-25 from 9 AM - 12 PM. Helpful information about the day of check-in will be emailed out before the event so you know exactly where to go and what to expect the first day. We look forward to it!

2. How are you responding to COVID-19?

We take your child's health and safety seriously! If for any reason you, your child, or a family member is at a high-risk for COVID-19, this may not be the best year to attend. We will keep our ratios small (groups of children 10 or less), limiting registrations if needed and will complete a detailed cleaning after each day's events. This event is subject to change as we monitor the COVID-19 situation over the coming weeks.

3. What is the sick policy at VBS?

Children attending need to be fever free (without Tylenol) for 72 hours and must be free of contagious symptoms such as cough, sore throat, difficulty breathing, rash, and any flu-like symptoms. If a child begins to feel ill at VBS, the parent/emergency contact provided will be called to pick up the child immediately. We are unable to keep children at VBS if they are sick.

4. Does my child need to wear a mask?

Masks worn for children over age 5 will be determined by Douglas County mandates.

5. Can my child be with his/her sibling/cousin/bff?

Children are grouped by grade and will have peers close in age in their group. Grade groupings will not be announced in advance of VBS due to not knowing exactly how many children will register in each age group. In order to keep our groups small and consistent throughout the week, we will not make changes to groups after VBS has started. 4. Can my child bring a friend?

YES!! We ask that any friends that would like to attend please register online. We are excited your child wants to include their friend this year at VBS!

5. What about my preschooler (3-4 years)? Can they attend too?

YES! Your 3-4 year old child can attend our preschool VBS as long as they are potty-trained. If the parent of a 3 year old (that is not potty-trained) serves as a volunteer at VBS, childcare is provided for them. Pre-registration is required and is available through the volunteer form. Space is limited for our childcare, so please register as soon as possible if you plan to serve.

6. Does it cost anything to attend?

We are so grateful to be able to offer VBS as a free outreach to children in our community. Your gift of any amount offsets the cost of approximately \$15 per child for snacks and supplies. If you are unable to give a gift, that's okay! Thank you for your generosity!
